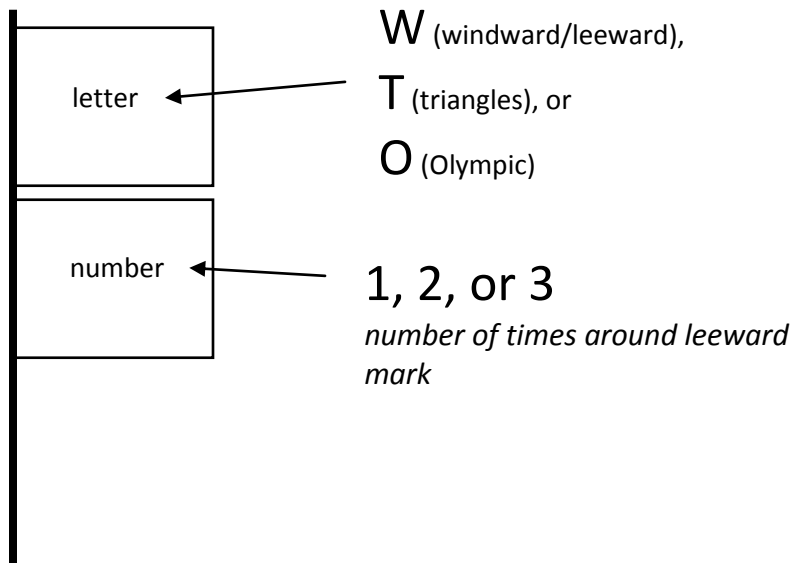


COURSES

TWO FLAGS, ONE OVER THE OTHER, (ON THE RC BOAT) INDICATES THE COURSE



Leave all marks to port

W – Marks: W (windward) and L (leeward)

Start, go around the two marks, repeat if necessary until you've passed the leeward mark the required number of times, finish.

T – Marks: W (windward), J (gybe), and L (leeward)

Start, go around the three marks, repeat if necessary until you've passed the leeward mark the required number of times, finish.

O – Marks: 1 triangle (W, J, and L) followed by windward/leewards (W and L)

Start, go around the W, J, and L marks (1 triangle), go around the W & L marks, repeat if necessary until you've passed the leeward mark the required number of times, finish. (Examples: O/2 = 1 triangle + 1 w/l = 2 times past L mark, O/3 = 1 triangle + 2 w/l = 3 times past L mark)

Where to finish?

1) If the **signal boat & start line is between the W & L marks**, then the finish line is on the other side of the signal boat between it and a pin mark with a blue flag.

2) If the **signal boat & start line is to leeward of the L mark**, then the finish line is to windward of the W mark between another RC boat and a pin mark with a blue flag.

Gate? The L (leeward) mark **might** be a gate, i.e. two large orange cylinders 30-40 yards apart. If it is, pass between the two and go out to either side.

Offset? The W (windward) mark **might** have an offset orange ball 20 yards or so to its left. If it does, pass it on your port side.
